Directions

- DO NOT DILUTE.
- Dip teats immediately after milking as a routine part of milking procedures.
- Dip to THOROUGHLY COVER at least the lower one-third of the teat (preferably to the base of the udder), IMMEDIATELY after every milking.
- Empty and clean dip cups after each milking, or during milking, if they become contaminated.
- Do not pour used dip back into original container.
- KEEP FROM FREEZING.
- Keep container closed to prevent contamination.
- Store container in an upright position.

Ingredients

The active ingredients in CHG Teat Dip are 0.35% chlorhexidine digluconate and 0.2% didecyl dimethyl ammonium chloride.

The inactive ingredients are water, polyglycitol (starch) syrup, hydroxyethyl cellulose thickener, ethoxylated alcohol, glucionic acid, and blue dye.
